Dear Sponsors,

My name is Barry Major. I am a long-time native of Haverhill, the President of Drew's Team, Inc and the father of Andrew Major. Drew was born on April 27, 2005 with a genetic disease called Cystic Fibrosis. Although many strides have been made over the past 20 years, this disease still does not have a cure. We need your help to fulfill the mission of Drew's Team.

The Drew's Team Story

When my wife and I first found out that Drew was born with Cystic Fibrosis (aka CF), we were devastated. After several weeks in intensive care and 2 surgeries later, we were able to focus on Drew's long term needs and started to do some research on the disease. After discovering the heavy financial impact that Cystic Fibrosis can have on a family, we decided spring into action.

With the help of a few family members, we established Drew's Team, Inc within a few short months and finally qualified with the IRS as a 501c3 non-profit organization in November 2006.

Our Mission

To provide financial assistance to families affected by Cystic Fibrosis. The majority of our funds will be used to provide financial support to children and their parents to properly maintain adequate care that is required to pay for doctors, hospital bills, medical supplies, physical therapy, travel & lodging and pharmaceutical expenses to improve the quality of life for those with cystic fibrosis.

What is Cystic Fibrosis?

Cystic fibrosis is an inherited chronic disease

that affects the lungs and digestive system of about 30,000 children and adults in the United States (70,000 worldwide). A defective gene and its protein product cause the body to produce unusually thick, sticky mucus that:

- clogs the lungs and leads to life-threatening lung infections; and
- obstructs the pancreas and stops natural enzymes from helping the body break down and absorb food.

In the 1950s, few children with cystic fibrosis lived to attend elementary school. Today, advances in research and medical treatments have further enhanced and extended life for children and adults with CF. Many people with the disease can now expect to live into their 30s, 40s and beyond.

Statistics

- About 1,000 new cases of cystic fibrosis are diagnosed each year.
- More than 70% of patients are diagnosed by age two.
- More than 45% of the CF patient population is age 18 or older.
- The predicted median age of survival for a person with CF is more than 37 years.

Our Request

We've worked very hard over the last 5 years to provide financial assistance to individuals affected by cystic fibrosis. Our grass-roots organization has funded parking programs, paid for overnight family stays at the hospital, and most recently established

an endowment fund at Children's Hospital in Boston. Please consider joining the fight against cystic fibrosis by sponsoring the 5th Annual "Beat CF" Golf Tournament. Your support will allow us to further assist families in need!
